We will be using white oak blanks donated by Mike Oglesby. The second workshop will be held on **July 20**th. This workshop is intended for club members who expect to attend the **SWAT 2013 Symposium** in Waco, Texas, in August. Our club will again host the hands-on sharpening booth at SWAT. The July workshop is to fine tune our sharpening skills.

We teach jig sharpening in the hands-on sharpening booth, therefore, the workshop will focus on jig sharpening.

A session of hand sharpening will be presented at the symposium on Friday and Saturday by Mike Oglesby and Buddy Compton.

Spin Tops Needed
